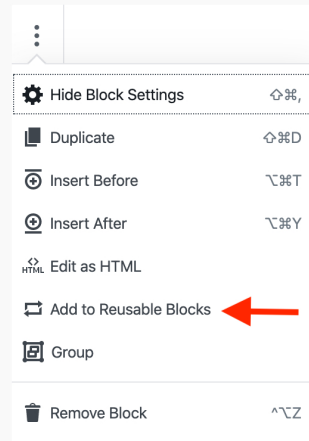
How to use Reusable Blocks

Great use cases for reusable blocks:

- Blocks you use repeatedly throughout your site.
 - Tiles
 - Elements you've added styles to
 - Groups of Blocks used to create a layout
 - Difficult to reconstruct layouts.

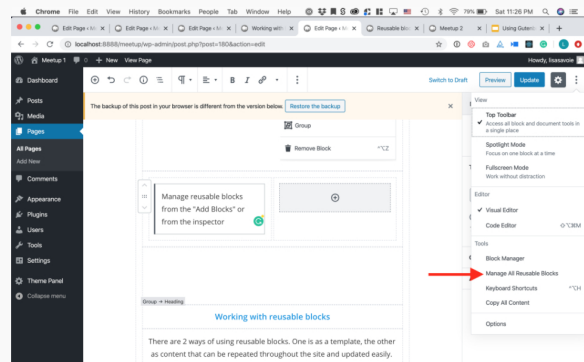
Adding a Reusable Block

Use the toolbar dropdown to add a block or group of blocks to "Reusable Blocks"



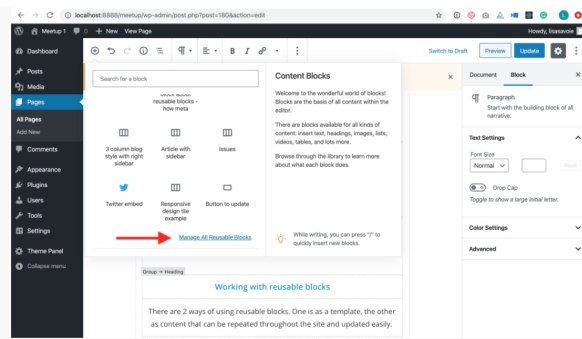
Managing Reusable Blocks

Manage reusable blocks from the "Add Blocks" or from the inspector



- Can edit the block (the edit will apply to all instances of

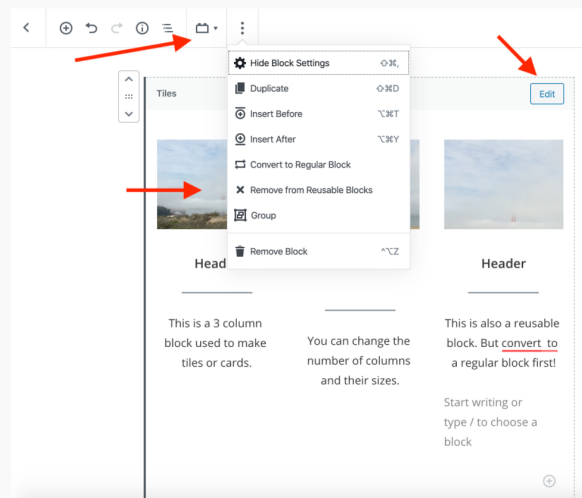
the reusable block), trash, or import/export as a JSON file.



Working with reusable blocks

There are 2 ways of using reusable blocks. One is as a **template**, the other as **content** that can be **repeated** throughout the site and updated easily.

- First, when creating a reusable block, make sure you've selected the entire block
- If using as content that is repeated, keep as a reusable block
- If using the block as a template, convert to a regular block



You've created a block. Now make it reusable. Reusable blocks can be used on multiple pages. They can be imported and exported as JSON files.

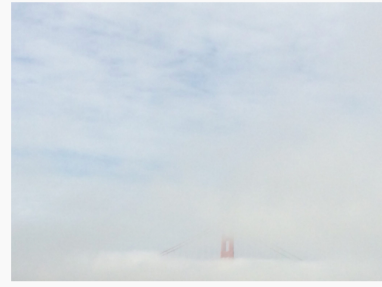

Blocks like these can be grouped together

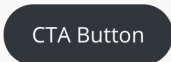
They can then be moved together or used as a reusable template
