

Accessing Customization Options

Toolbar


The block toolbar can be at the top of the page or at the top of the block.

• Set in the "More Tools & Options" dropdown.




Inspector

Can set a CSS class for an element.



More Tools & Options

- Keyboard shortcuts menu
 - Mac: ctrl + option + h
 - o PC: shift + alt + h





Adding Blocks

There are multiple ways to add a block.

- Anywhere there is a circle with a plus sign
 - o upper left corner
 - o the left side
 - o at the top of a block
- Also if you choose the menu in the toolbar, there's an option to add a block above or below.
- You can also "return" after a block to get the next block
- You can duplicate a block will keep the settings.
- Can drag/drop a photo into the editor to create an image block. Or several to create a gallery.
- You can "copy all content" and then paste it on a new page.






Choosing block type

After selecting circle/+:




- Scroll or search to choose a block
- Hovering over a block will show info about the block.





- If in the editor screen:
 - o Keyboard shortcut: / and then first letters of block
 - If you want a paragraph you can start typing.
 - $\circ\;$ Keyboard shortcut similar to the classic editor
 - ##(space) give you an h2 and so forth



- *(space) starts a list
- Hover over the next block and some options appear to the right



Select a block by changing the block:

- You can change this list
- to a paragraph
- very easily
- by choosing the selected block icon and changing block type



Dropping photo(s) into the editor creates a block and chooses the image or gallery block.


Copy & Paste a doc creates blocks and chooses the block type.


Removing blocks

... > Remove Block

Select block > Delete

• If you're trying to delete an element within a reusable block use "Delete" rather than "Remove Block"





Moving Blocks


The handle and the arrows move the blocks.

• If using the handle – move the handle (indent it) to fall below the block you want it under.



• Sometimes you need to get close to the drop before you can place it properly.






Editing Blocks & Block options


Select the block to edit by:


- selecting the block
- hovering over the corner including the corner of nested blocks.
- using the Block Navigation in the toolbar.

Editing options are in the toolbar & inspector.

Can add CSS classes to target an element for styling.









Edit photo size and shape

Edit the font size.



Set text color

To return – but not start another block – shift + return.




Use h's as an HTML anchor

Set the text and background color.

LAYOUT Adding Columns

Columns are Blocks

Columns of various widths and amounts can be added. The columns can contain any other block.



Adjusting Column Widths

Adjust the width of columns from left to right. The remaining space will be divided among the columns to the right.

These columns are spaced 25%, 50%, 25%



The first column was enlarged to 35%. The 2nd column is now 45%. the 3rd column is now 20%. The 10% increase to column 1 was evenly taken away from columns 2 & 3.

Layering Blocks


Columns can be layered over columns

This is a 3 column layout with additional columns layered within the 3 columns.




If you leave an open spot it holds the space.

Blocks can be layered over cover blocks



Layer a reusable block over a cover image w/spacer



The overlay on cover block photos can be edited Can also add a fixed background for a parallax effect

Combining Blocks within Columns



Use Text Settings to Change Font Sizes

- Change vertical alignment to match your design.
- Change overlay text to white to be able to see the text.



Media & Text block is designed to be layered



Remember to "stack on mobile" Media & Text blocks.

FLEXIBILITY

You or a plugin developer can create reusable blocks

Use as templates or as elements repeated throughout your site. Keeps any CSS class added to the blocks.





Header

This is a 3 column block used to make tiles or cards.

Header

You can change the number of columns and their sizes.

Header

This is also a reusable block which can be edited or repeated.
